Dear seaweed farmer,

Let's start off with stating how excited I am to connect with you regarding the fascinating world of seaweed farming. Since I'm completely captivated by this fast-developing industry, and since I have a strong belief in the immense potential of seaweed cultivation in addressing various ecological challenges, I'm eager to find an opportunity to work at an innovative seaweed farm. Please allow me to introduce myself briefly and elaborate a bit on where my dedication to work with seaweed comes from – hopefully you'll see a potential match.

I'm a 29-year-old from Rotterdam, the Netherlands, with up until one and a half years ago a very much non farming background. I actually graduated as an urban and architectural historian and worked as a researcher and consultant in the field of sustainable urban development. Although I was very passionate about this, I quite quickly came to the realization that it wasn't my long-term calling. There were simply to many people talking about sustainable building materials and practices, but only a few seemed to offer true hands-on perspectives on how to shape the future of this field. Just know that my interest in seaweed cultivation simply surpasses everything else, and this is the industry where I truly envision myself a future in.

At the moment, I just finished my second year at school and I'm eagerly seeking an opportunity to undertake an apprenticeship in the upcoming year. This would involve working full-time (for ideally 6-12 months, but more or less would certainly be up for discussion) in everything that's at hand with seaweed farming and the processing into end products. What you would get in return is someone who's extremely passionate, who's willing to live anywhere in the world in order to make a dream come true, and who's genuinely familiar with hard work; my time in New Zealand is a vivid statement to this, as life as a shepherd is far from easy. Additionally, I have extensively delved into the topic of seaweed farming, attended the Nordic Seaweed Conference 2023 to be up to date with the industries developments, and completed the online course by GreenWave. The only thing I aspire to do next is find an opportunity to work with seaweed first-hand. However, if such an opportunity isn't available within your company, I'm more than open to any suggestions, if you have any!
